A versatile manikin for training in hospitals and care homes. For realistic training in emergency evacuations, working with rescue equipment and lifting equipment or simple handling exercises. To avoid back injuries through the correct handling of the patient.

- an extended plastic reinforcement in the back enables sitting upright in bed or wheelchair
- reinforcements in the thighs prevent overstretching when lifting
- arms and legs can be removed to enable training with amputees. It also makes it easier to transport
- soft joints to avoid bruises during training
- the lower part of the doll was weighted to enable better sitting
- the arms can be held together by Velcro fasteners on the wrist or attached to a handle
- possibility to put on a ruff
- supplied undressed so that the doll can be dressed individually according to the scenario
- made from the flame-retardant material that is also used in police ballistic / puncture vests (corresponds to OEKO-TEX Standard 100, BS EN ISO 12947-2 & 14116: 2008) - the material is robust, safe to use and very light to clean
